**Filing Deadline: Monday, July 4, 2016 at 4:00 p.m.**

All applicants must be a qualified elector as defined in the Municipal Elections Act.

As of Tuesday, July 12, 2016 he or she must be:

- A Canadian citizen
- At least 18 years old, and
- Residing in the Township of Nipissing, or is the owner or tenant of land in the Township of Nipissing, or the spouse of such a person; and
- Is not prohibited from voting (as per the Municipal Elections Act) or otherwise by law.

### *Landfill Reminders*

### *2016 Road Construction – Highway 654*

The Ministry of Transportation recently awarded the contract for the reconstruction of Highway 654 to Teranorth Construction. The work will include rehabilitation of Hwy 654 from Hwy 534 for 22.7 km to Hwy 11. The anticipated timelines for the work scheduled is May 2016 to the Fall of 2017.
