 - Municipality had a risk assessment completed noting that nothing should be placed within 3 ft. of electrical panels.
- iii. Summer Event Planning:
 - Grand Opening, June 15th: Brenda will send out invites to MP, MPP, mayors, Mary will contact newspapers, Linda will contact CTV. Norah will ask the Harpist to play music in the church.
- iv. Human Resources New Hires: Both students have accepted the positions. Budgeted for full time employment.
