
Mission Statement

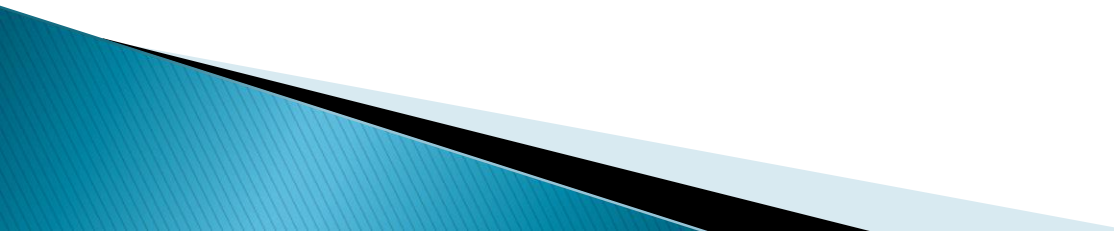
Vision Statement


NEXT STEPS


LANDFILL MANAGEMENT

Changes Required for the Sustained
Management of the Township Landfill Sites


Bear Creek Landfill Updates

- ▶ Estimated remaining lifespan of 4 years
 - ▶ Estimated post-closure costs \$851,344
 - ▶ Working with consultants to investigate expansion of the fill area
- 

Wolfe Lake Landfill Updates

- ▶ Estimated remaining lifespan of 17.5 years
 - ▶ Estimated post closure costs \$407,950
- 

Next Steps:

- ▶ Research improved waste diversion initiatives.
 - ▶ Consider bag limits.
 - ▶ Utilize a Landfill Card system that tracks the number of bags.
 - ▶ Work with commercial properties and tourist camps to best support the waste limits approach.
