Property Tax Information:

Property taxes are sent out in two installments each year. The interim tax bill is due **March 31st, 2024** and is based on half of the previous year's total taxes. The final tax bill is sent out in June and is due **September 30th, 2024**. Once the annual budget is adopted by Council the tax rate is applied to your property assessment which determines your total property taxes for the year.



The Township of Nipissing accepts the following payment options:

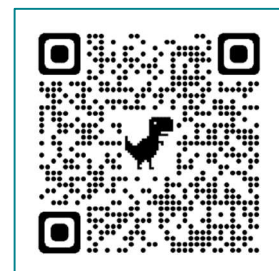
Online banking, cheques and post-dated cheques, debit or cash in person at the municipal office. Please note credit card payments and e-transfers are not accepted.

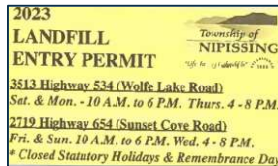

News from the Fire Department



Blowing snow and ice can cover your 911 sign, making it difficult for emergency services to locate the address should they be required. Please remove snow and ice from both sides of the green sign blade and keep the sign post clear of snow, to ensure it doesn't fall over during snow removal.

Make sure your furnace and hot water tank vents are clear of snow and ice. Otherwise, deadly carbon monoxide can build up inside your home. Verify you have a working CO detector outside of all sleeping areas in your home. Never operate a generator inside of garages or sheds or CO can build up to dangerous and potentially lethal levels.



On the Roads

Please drive according to road and weather conditions, and watch for the plow trucks. Our drivers work diligently to maintain and keep our roads safe before, during and after a storm. All of this takes time and care.

All of our trucks are equipped with GPS tracking so we can effectively plow and sand the Township according to weather conditions.

Section 181 of the Highway Traffic Act prohibits the depositing of snow or ice on roadways and sidewalks. By-Law 2021-63 prohibits the pushing of snow over municipal roadways.
