Discussion:

- a) Bottle Drive: Bottles were collected on Friday and Sunday for the month of January 2024

- b) Chair Yoga:
 - Marg provided an update to the first 2 weeks of the program. On January 29th, the class had 22 participants and on February 5th 20 participants with new participants at the February 5th class.
