1. Council approved the Powassan and District Union Public Library 2025 Budget

The Township provides support to the library for Township residents to utilize the library and its services and programs. Currently 20% of residents have an active library card.

2. Council approved the participation in the City of North Bay Household Hazardous Waste Program for 2025.

The City of North Bay invites surrounding municipalities to participate in the City's Hazardous Waste Program. The Township of Nipissing will once again participate in this program, the cost per residence is \$4.00. Township of Nipissing residences can visit 112 Patton Street, free of charge, Wednesday to Saturday from 8:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. year-round.
