

Cemetery Work Plan - Nipissing Union Cemetery 2025

### **BACKGROUND/OVERVIEW**

 Lack of fencing along the western edge of the old section of the Nipissing Union Cemetery has been an issue for a few years with the direction change of a snowmobile trail during the winter months. The South Shore Restoule Snowmobile Club has responded to our concerns and placed snow fencing along the edge to keep machines away from the monuments during the season. A reserve has been created for the installation of the fencing with an accumulated total of \$7,646.00 at December 31, 2024.

A quote has been obtained for 75 feet of Alden ornamental fence, 5 feet in height with 2 inch square posts and caps. The total is \$8,696.00 plus applicable taxes. This will result in an additional \$2,200 required in the budget.

Tree removal and brushing has been performed along the edges of the cemetery and the ravine between the new and older sections. Trees that are dead or dying and pose a threat to the monuments within the grounds have been removed.

Brushing of the land purchased for the cemetery has started as the Public Works crew has availability. This will continue for the next few years as there is still adequate space in the new section.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Staff recommends approval of the Fence quotation for the installation and provision of fencing along the old section of the west side of Nipissing Union Cemetery.

Cemetery Work Plan – St. John's Alsace Cemetery 2025

### **BACKGROUND/OVERVIEW**

There is limited space available at the Alsace Cemetery. We are no longer able to
accommodate full casket burials without investigation and sounding of the area. This
eliminates pre-need sales in the cemetery and requires future planning to ensure
continued use of the area.

The land adjacent to the cemetery is approximately 2 acres which we have been exploring for expansion purposes. We have requested a quote from a local surveyor for the work of surveying the remaining land for cemetery use. There is also a request process required from the Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO) to add any land to our current operating licence and authority.

Records have been located that indicate the land was retained for the purpose of expanding the cemetery with the harvesting of the pine trees on the lot to be used towards any ongoing costs. The use of Care and Maintenance Funds can be used for this project and will a request for approval to use the funds will be forwarded to the BAO once authorized by the Committee, Council and all estimates are received.

The expansion is expected to provide burial lots of up to 200 spaces, create an esthetically pleasing driveway between the existing section and new section, and allow for pre-need purchasing and planning of burial lots by families once again.

2. There is a large spruce tree located on the left side of the cemetery as you enter the gate. This tree is dying and poses a risk to the cemetery monuments in place and the sanctity of the grounds surrounding it, including the root system.

Due to the complex nature of removal and the size of the tree, staff recommends the use of a professional arborist for the project. A quote has been obtained as a guide in the amount of \$2,000.00.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Staff recommends approval of the continued investigation, project quoting and approval request for the expansion of the St. John's Alsace Cemetery.

Staff also recommends the approval of the quote received for the removal of the tree in the St. John's Alsace Cemetery as provided.

### **BACKGROUND/OVERVIEW**

#### Revenue:

Anticipated revenue for burials, monument foundations and sale of lots remains the same each year as this is a difficult estimate to establish.

The Interest amount for cemetery refers to the amount of interest received on the Care and Maintenance funds held in trust each year. Under the Cemetery Act we are permitted to transfer the interest to our operating expenses to assist in the management of the cemetery.

An amount in the Cemetery Reserve of \$7,600 for fencing will be moved to the operating budget for 2025.

A request for the estimated costs of a survey for the Alsace Cemetery expansion will be made to the Bereavement Authority of Ontario to utilize the funds from the Care and Maintenance Fund.

#### **Expenses:**

Salary expenses increased in response to 2024 usage and to increasing wages and benefits of staff. A student is usually hired to maintain the cemeteries in the summer with the assistance of one Public Works Staff to off-set this cost.

#### Other expenses include:

Removal of tree at Alsace Cemetery \$2,000
Fencing at Nipissing Union Cemetery \$10,000
Survey and expansion costs at Alsace Cemetery \$15,000
Plus \$8,000 for regular costs including insurance, equipment

Plus \$8,000 for regular costs including insurance, equipment maintenance, cemetery supplies including cement for foundations and the rental/use of equipment.

An expense of grounds reserve will not be required in 2025 as we are using the previously saved amounts towards the fencing this year. This may be re-instated in future years when there is a project to set money aside for.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Staff recommends approval of the proposed 2025 Cemetery Budget.
