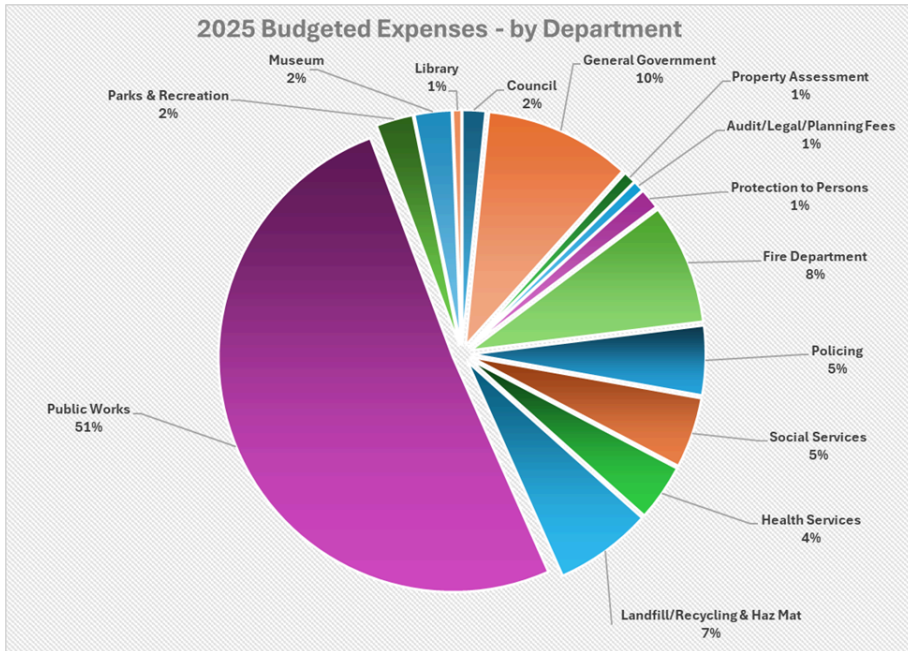

Budget 2025 Overview



Municipal Tax Levy Increase 4.66%

Municipal Tax Rate Increase 3.95%

Tax Impact: Per \$216,000 of assessment \$85.42 increase

The Final 2025 tax installment is due on September 30th, 2025

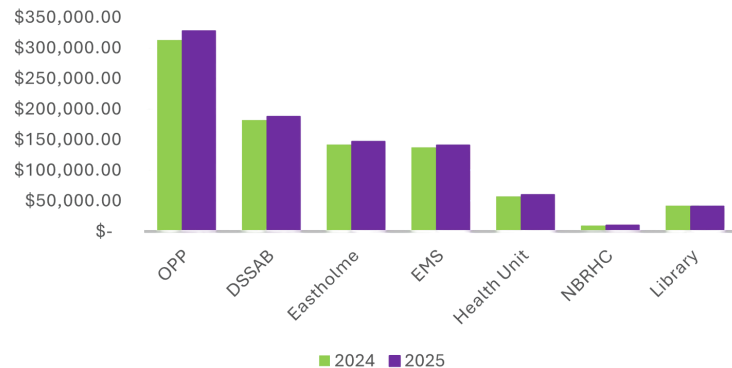
Payment options include cash, cheque, debit or online payment through your banking institution. Please note that the Township **DOES NOT** accept E-Transfer or credit card payments.

Homes built after 2015 must have interconnected smoke alarms on every level and in every sleeping room, along with visual strobe lights and battery backup. CO alarms are mandated near sleeping areas if the home has an attached garage, fuel-burning appliance, or fireplace.

WAS YOUR HOME BUILT IN 2015?

IT'S TIME TO REPLACE EXPIRED SMOKE ALARMS WITH SAME LEVEL OF PROTECTION



Smoke Alarm Regulations:

- Homes built before 2014: Require smoke alarms on every level and outside sleeping areas.
- Homes built after 2014: Require interconnected smoke alarms on every level and in each sleeping room, with visual strobe lights and battery backup.
- Maintenance: Alarms should be tested monthly and replaced every 7-10 years, or sooner if they show signs of malfunction.

Carbon Monoxide (CO) Alarm Regulations:

- CO alarms are required in all homes, regardless of age, if they have an attached garage, fuel-burning appliance (furnace, water heater, etc.), or a fireplace.
- CO alarms must be installed near sleeping areas, typically in the hallway or area outside bedrooms.

Additional Information:

- Property Owners Responsibility: Property Owners are responsible for ensuring smoke and CO alarms are working in rental properties, and tenants should report any issues.
- Disabling Alarms: It is illegal to disable smoke alarms.
- Penalties: Violations of the Fire Protection and Prevention Act can result in fines.

Tax Payment Options

The Township accepts the following payments:

Online Banking: Agreements are in place for online banking services with all major banks and some credit unions. Register the Township as a Vendor, your 19-digit Roll Number is your account number, beginning with 4971.

Current or Post-Dated Cheques made payable to the Township of Nipissing, accepted at the Township Office, via mail or through the drop-box at the Township Office.

Debit or Cash at the Township Office, Monday to Friday during regular scheduled office hours.

The Township **does not** accept Credit Cards or E-Transfers.
